

INTERNET BEDROOM PRIVACY POLICY

Last Updated: July 10, 2026

Discz Music, Inc. ("Internet Bedroom," "we," "us," or "our") welcomes you. We have created this privacy policy (this "Privacy Policy") because we know that you care about how information you provide to us is used and shared. This Privacy Policy relates to the information collection and use practices of Internet Bedroom in connection with the Internet Bedroom web application and related websites (collectively, the "Service"), which is made available to you at <https://internetbedroom.com>.

BY CREATING A BEDROOM, CLAIMING A HANDLE, ENTERING YOUR INFORMATION, OR OTHERWISE USING THE SERVICE YOU: (A) ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTOOD, AND AGREE TO BE LEGALLY BOUND BY THIS PRIVACY POLICY AND (B) REPRESENT THAT YOU ARE 13 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. If you do not agree to any of these terms, then please do not use the Service. This Privacy Policy may be updated by us from time to time with or without notice to you.

Capitalized terms not defined in this Privacy Policy shall have the meaning set forth in our Terms of Use.

I. Age Requirements

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 13 through the Service. If you are under 13, please do not use the Service or provide us with any personal information. We encourage parents and legal guardians to monitor their children's Internet usage and to help enforce our Privacy Policy by instructing their children never to provide personal information through the Service without their permission. If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of 13 has provided personal information to us, please contact us at support@housewarming.me, and we will delete that information from our databases.

II. The Information We Collect and/or Receive

In the course of operating the Service, we will collect and/or receive the following types of information. You authorize us to collect and/or receive such information.

Account and Login Information

You can view bedrooms without creating an account. If you want to claim your bedroom — including choosing a handle, saving your customizations, and receiving daily updates and decor — you will be asked to provide an email address and to choose a handle and/or display name (which do not need to be your actual name). We will refer to your email address and the names and handle you have chosen to provide to us as the "Login Information."

Profile and Room Information

When you claim and customize your bedroom, you may provide additional information such as a bedroom title, a bio, a chosen theme, decor selections, posters, and other customizations (the "Room Information"). **Please remember that your bedroom is public:** your handle, bedroom title, bio, decor, custom uploads, guestbook entries, visitor count, and other room contents are visible to anyone who visits your bedroom's URL.

Music Data

To generate and refresh your bedroom, you may connect one or more third-party music streaming accounts, such as Spotify or Apple Music (each a "Music Service"). When you connect a Music Service, we receive information from that Music Service as authorized by you and permitted by that Music Service, which may include your listening history, top and recently played artists and tracks, playlists, and related profile information (collectively, "Music Data"). We use Music Data to generate your bedroom, select decor and songs, and update your bedroom over time as your listening changes. You can disconnect a Music Service at any time through your account settings or by contacting us, though some features of the Service (including automatic room generation and daily updates) may stop working. Your use of any Music Service is also governed by that Music Service's own privacy policy.

User Contributions

As described in more detail in our Terms of Use, the Service allows you to customize your bedroom, upload your own images and stickers, and interact with other users' bedrooms, including by signing guestbooks and leaving stamps and emoji (collectively, "User Contributions"), some of which may contain personal information. This information is transmitted to others at your own risk, and can be collected and used by third parties and by us without limitation. By uploading another person's personal information or image on Internet Bedroom, you confirm that you have all necessary rights and permissions to provide and share such information.

You can review your bedroom and the contributions you have made, and contact us at support@housewarming.me to remove any of them. If you believe somebody has provided us with your personal information and you would like us to remove it from our database, please contact us at support@housewarming.me.

Purchase Information

If we offer Coins, Virtual Items, or other features for purchase and you choose to make a purchase, your payment will be processed by our third-party payment processor (such as Stripe). We do not store your full payment card number. We receive from the payment processor information such as confirmation of your purchase, the item purchased, the amount, and limited billing details (the "Purchase Information"). The payment processor's handling of your payment details is governed by its own privacy policy.

Visitor and Activity Information

When you visit a bedroom (your own or someone else's), we collect information about that visit, such as which bedrooms you visit and when, in order to power features like visitor counts, guestbook notifications, and neighborhood suggestions.

Other Information

In addition to the information described above, we may collect additional information (the "Other Information"). Such Other Information may include:

From your activity. Information that we automatically collect when you use the Service, including, without limitation:

- IP addresses, browser type and language, referring and exit pages and URLs, date and time, amount of time spent on particular pages, what sections of the Service you visit, etc.;
- Information about your device, including device identifiers, operating system, hardware information, and network type;
- Activity and usage information occurring via the Service, including customizations, favorites, preferences, session lengths, traffic data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on or through the Service, and similar data.

From cookies. We collect information using "cookie" technology. Cookies are small packets of data that are stored on your device so that it will "remember" information about your visit. We

use such cookies to help us collect Other Information and to enhance your experience using the Service (for example, keeping you signed in). If you do not want us to place a cookie on your device, you may be able to turn that feature off in your browser settings. Please consult your browser's documentation for information on how to do this and how to delete persistent cookies. However, if you decide not to accept cookies from us, certain aspects of the Service may not function properly.

Third-Party Analytics. We use one or more third-party analytics services (such as Google Analytics and Amplitude) to evaluate your use of the Service, compile reports on activity (based on their collection of IP addresses, internet service provider, browser type, operating system and language, referring and exit pages and URLs, date and time, amount of time spent on particular pages, and other similar usage data), and analyze performance metrics. These third parties use cookies and other technologies to help analyze and provide us the data. By accessing and using the Service, you consent to the processing of data about you by these analytics providers in the manner and for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. IV. How We Use and Share Information

We use the Login Information, Room Information, Music Data, User Contributions, Purchase Information, Visitor and Activity Information, and Other Information (collectively, the "Information") to: (i) provide you with access to your bedroom and Account and to maintain and secure such Account; (ii) generate, personalize, and update your bedroom, including through automated and AI-assisted features; (iii) power social features such as guestbooks, visitor counts, and neighborhoods; (iv) process transactions and manage Coins and Virtual Items; (v) store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize your experience according to your individual interests; (vi) notify you of activity related to your bedroom (such as when someone signs your guestbook) and when updates are available; (vii) contact you to respond to inquiries related to the Service; (viii) communicate with you to provide you with relevant information about Internet Bedroom, including special promotions, discounts and newsletters; (ix) provide you with support, to respond to your inquiries, and to solicit feedback; (x) identify, investigate, respond to, and prevent fraudulent or illegal activity (such as incidents of hacking or misuse of the Service) and other liabilities; (xi) enhance or repair the functionality of the Service or improve our services; and (xii) inform you about our products and services and those of our third-party marketing partners.

You also authorize us to use and/or share your Information as described below.

Public Display

Your bedroom is publicly accessible at your bedroom's URL. Your handle, bedroom title, bio, decor, custom uploads, songs, guestbook entries left by visitors, visitor count, and similar room contents are visible to anyone who visits that URL, and may be indexed by search engines or shared by others outside the Service.

Agents, Affiliates, Providers and Other Third Parties

We may engage other companies and individuals to perform certain business-related functions on our behalf. Examples include providing technical assistance, payment processing, customer service, marketing assistance, cloud hosting and storage services, and AI service providers. These other companies will have access to the Information only as necessary to perform their functions and to the extent permitted by law. We may also share your Information with any of our parent companies, subsidiaries, or other companies under common control with us.

Marketing

As permitted by applicable law, we may use your Information for marketing purposes, such as informing you about our products and services and those of our third-party marketing partners that could be useful, relevant, valuable, or otherwise of interest to you. We may also share your Information with third parties that are not service providers or vendors, so that those third parties can send you information about their products and/or services. Where required under applicable law, we will obtain your prior opt-in consent to send you electronic marketing communications. If you do not wish to have your Information shared directly with third parties as described above (other than our service providers and vendors), please submit your request to our email at support@housewarming.me.

Aggregated Information

In an ongoing effort to better understand users of the Service, we might analyze your Information in aggregate form in order to operate, maintain, manage, and improve the Service. This aggregate information does not identify you personally. We may share this aggregate data with our affiliates, agents, and business partners, and may share and sell this aggregate information to other unaffiliated third parties. We may also disclose aggregated user statistics in order to describe our Service to current and prospective business partners and to other third parties for other lawful purposes.

Business Transfers

As we develop our business, we might sell or buy other assets or businesses. In the event of a corporate sale, merger, reorganization, sale of assets, dissolution, or similar event, your Information may be part of the transferred assets associated with such transaction.

Legal Requirements and Enforcement of Our Policies

To the extent permitted by law, we may also disclose your Information: (i) when required by law, court order, or other government or law enforcement authority or regulatory agency; or (ii) whenever we believe that disclosing such information is necessary or advisable, for example, to protect the rights, property, or safety of Internet Bedroom or others. We may disclose your information to enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including our Terms of Use and this Privacy Policy or if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Internet Bedroom, our customers or others.

Otherwise With Your Consent

We may also disclose your information to fulfill any purpose for which you provide it or for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the Information.

V. How We Protect Your Information

We take commercially reasonable steps to protect your Information from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction. Please understand, however, that no security system is impenetrable. We cannot guarantee the security of our databases or the databases of the third parties with which we may share such information, nor can we guarantee that the information you supply will not be intercepted while being transmitted over the Internet. In particular, e-mail sent to us may not be secure, and you should therefore take special care in deciding what information you send to us via e-mail.

If you post User Contributions or make content available in your bedroom, that information is transmitted to others at your own risk, and can be collected and used by third parties and by us without limitation. We cannot control the actions of third parties who view your public bedroom or with whom you may choose to share your bedroom's link. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

VI. External Sites

The Service may contain links to other third-party websites, products or services not owned or controlled by Internet Bedroom ("External Sites"), including Music Services and links placed by

other users. Internet Bedroom has no control over the privacy practices or the content of these External Sites. As such, we are not responsible for the content or the privacy policies of those External Sites, and you should check the applicable third-party privacy policy and terms of use when visiting any External Sites.

VII. Electronic Communications and Opting Out

When you communicate with us electronically, via e-mail or otherwise, you consent to our use of the Information you have provided, and you further consent to receive electronic communications from us. If you would prefer not to receive marketing communications, you can unsubscribe from our e-mail lists by clicking on the "unsubscribe" link at the bottom of the e-mail you receive from us. Even if you unsubscribe from marketing, we may still send you transactional and account-related messages (such as security alerts and purchase confirmations). You should be aware, however, that (i) it is not always possible to completely remove or modify personal information, or other information in our databases and servers, although we will always make reasonable efforts to do so upon your request, and (ii) we are unable to have your personal information, or other information removed from the records of any third party who has been provided with your information in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

VIII. Do Not Track Signals

Some web browsers may give you the ability to enable a "do not track" setting that is an HTTP header field indicating your preferences regarding user tracking or cross-site tracking. We do not recognize web browser "do not track" signals at this time, and we do not alter our Service's data collection and use practices when we see a do not track signal from your browser. Instead, information collection and disclosure practices and the choices that we provide to users will continue to operate as described in this Privacy Policy, whether or not a "do not track" signal is received. Annex I — GDPR Privacy Notice

If you are a resident of the European Union ("EU"), United Kingdom, Liechtenstein, Norway, or Iceland, you may have additional rights under the EU General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR") with respect to your Personal Data, as outlined in this GDPR Addendum (the "Addendum").

For this Addendum, we use the terms "Personal Data" and "processing" as they are defined in the GDPR, but "Personal Data" generally means information that can be used to identify a person, and "processing" generally refers to actions that can be performed on data such as its collection, use, storage or disclosure.

Internet Bedroom (Discz Music, Inc.) will be the controller of your Personal Data processed in connection with the Service. Where applicable, this Addendum is intended to supplement, and not replace, our Privacy Policy. If there are any conflicts between the Addendum and the other parts of the Privacy Policy, the policy or portion that is more protective of Personal Data shall control to the extent of such conflict.

Types of Personal Data we Collect

We currently collect and otherwise process the kinds of Personal Data listed above in the "Information We Collect and/or Receive" section of the Privacy Policy, including Music Data received from connected Music Services and information processed by our automated generation features as described in the "Automated Generation and AI Features" section.

How we get the Personal Data and why we have it

We receive the Personal Data in the ways and for the purposes listed above in the Privacy Policy. Under the GDPR, the lawful bases we rely on for processing this information are:

Your consent. You can remove your consent at any time. You can do this by contacting us via email at support@housewarming.me with the subject line "GDPR Request." For example, we receive Music Data from a Music Service only after you consent by connecting your Music Service account, and you may disconnect it at any time.

We have a contractual obligation. We process Personal Data as necessary to provide our services in accordance with the Terms of Use, including generating and maintaining your bedroom and processing purchases.

We have a legitimate interest.

- **Information Security:** We process contact information, and the information collected through cookies and when you use the Service in order to maintain an audit log of activities performed. We use this information pursuant to our legitimate interests in tracking Service usage, combating distributed denial-of-service (DDOS) or other attacks, and removing or defending against malicious individuals or programs.
- **Service Operation and Improvement:** We process server log information and information collected through cookies pursuant to our legitimate interest in operating and improving our Service.
- **Feature Improvement:** We may process aggregated and anonymized data to improve our generation and personalization features pursuant to our legitimate interest in providing better services to our users.
- **Audience Measurement and Retargeting:** Pursuant to a user's consent, we use analytics cookies, and collect identifiers through such cookies, for purposes of audience measurement, analytics, audience reaction to the Service, and creating relevant user experiences.
- **General Business Development and Management:** We process Personal Data pursuant to our legitimate interest in creating and managing our business relationships with European Individuals, including without limitation: to respond to inquiries from European Individuals; to provide European Individuals with information about our products and services; and to assist European Individuals with any issues while using the Service.
- **Direct Marketing:** Generally, we send marketing communications to European Individuals pursuant to their consent. When you use the Service, and if allowed under applicable law, we may also send you marketing messages pursuant to our legitimate interest in sending such communications to you in the context of our business relationship.
- **Protection of Rights:** We may also disclose Personal Data to respond to claims of violation of third party rights or to enforce and protect our rights.

We have a legal obligation. We may be required to disclose personal data in response to lawful requests by public authorities, including for the purpose of meeting national security or law enforcement requirements. We may also disclose personal data to other third parties when compelled to do so by government authorities or required by law or regulation including, but not limited to, in response to court orders and subpoenas.

How we store your personal information

We use commercially reasonable administrative, technical, and physical safeguards to protect your Personal Data from loss, misuse, and unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction, for which we take into account the nature of the Personal Data, its processing, and the threats posed to it. Unfortunately, no data transmission or storage system can be guaranteed to be secure at all times. If you have reason to believe that your interaction with us is no longer secure, please immediately notify us via email at support@housewarming.me.

We retain your Personal Data for as long as needed to fulfill the purposes for which we obtained it, as further described in this Privacy Policy. We will only keep your Personal Data for as long as allowed or required by law.

Your data protection rights

Under data protection law, you have rights, which include:

- **Right of access:** You have the right to ask us for copies of your Personal Data.
- **Right to rectification:** You have the right to ask us to rectify Personal Data you think is inaccurate. You also have the right to ask us to complete information you think is incomplete.
- **Right to erasure:** You have the right to ask us to erase your Personal Data in certain circumstances.
- **Right to restriction of processing:** You have the right to ask us to restrict the processing of your Personal Data in certain circumstances.
- **Right to object to processing:** You have the right to object to the processing of your Personal Data in certain circumstances, including processing by automated or AI systems.
- **Right to data portability:** You have the right to ask that we transfer the Personal Data you gave us to another organization, or to you, in certain circumstances.
- **Right to withdraw consent:** You have the right to withdraw your consent where consent is used as the legal basis for processing your Personal Data.

- **Rights related to automated decision-making:** You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you, except where such processing is necessary for entering into or performing a contract, authorized by law, or based on your explicit consent.
- **Objecting to Legitimate Interest/Direct Marketing:** You may object to Personal Data processed pursuant to our legitimate interest. In such case, we will no longer process your Personal Data unless we can demonstrate appropriate, overriding legitimate grounds for the processing or if needed for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims. You may also object at any time to processing of your Personal Data for direct marketing purposes by clicking "Unsubscribe" within an automated marketing email or by submitting your request to support@housewarming.me with the subject line "GDPR Request." In such case, your Personal Data will no longer be used for that purpose.

You are not required to pay any charge for exercising your rights. If you make a request, we have one month to respond to you. Please contact us at support@housewarming.me with the subject line "GDPR Request" if you wish to make a request.

How to complain

If you have any concerns about our use of your Personal Data, you can make a complaint to us at support@housewarming.me with the subject line "GDPR Request."

You also have the right to lodge a complaint about the processing of your personal data with a supervisory authority of the European state where you work or live or where any alleged infringement of data protection laws occurred. Corporate Restructuring

In the event of a merger, reorganization, dissolution, or similar corporate event, or the sale of all or substantially all of our assets, the information that we have collected, including Personal Data, may be transferred to the surviving or acquiring entity. All such transfers shall be subject to our commitments with respect to the privacy and confidentiality of such Personal Data as set forth in this Addendum.

Updates to this Addendum

If, in the future, we intend to process your Personal Data for a purpose other than that which it was collected, we will provide you with information on that purpose and any other relevant information at a reasonable time prior to such processing. After such time, the relevant information relating to such processing activity will be revised or added appropriately within this Addendum, and the "Last Updated" at the top of this page will be updated accordingly.
